

DALEY 1980

In 1980, Father Joseph Daley became the associate pastor at Holy Name. Born February 8, 1942 in New Jersey, Father Daley was ordained in 1968 and served first at Fort Lee, New Jersey. Working [Sheridan Holy Name 1985, 68] mainly with the youth. Father Daley held altar boy classes and got the number of boys up from 6 to 66. He also did extensive research for the Catechumenate program and compiled it into a book. Father Daley enjoyed the parish and neighborliness and described Holy Name as “the most active -ALIVE -parish I was ever in. The rectory phone and doorbell rang morning, noon and night.” In 1980, the Knights of Columbus purchased a building on East Brundage Street, which they remodeled into a meeting room, office, kitchen and recreation room. Bishop Hart dedicated the building in May of 1981.
