Since 1925 the following pastors have served "The Church of Corpus Christi" and its missions.

Father Bernard Schneiders to July 1933 when he returned to Holland.

Father Nicholas Endres served from July 1933 to September 1933 when he resigned.

Father James McBride served from September 1933 to October 1938, when the present pastor assumed charge.

Since 1925 the following improvements were made in the parish: The foundation of "The Church of Corpus Christi" was repaired and rebuilt in places; furnaces were installed in the church and rectory; a cement floor was placed in the cellar of the house.

During the past year there have been nineteen baptisms and eight marriages.

Confirmation was administered on May 20, 1937. Twelve candidates were confirmed.

Twenty people were confirmed May 15, 1934.

Twenty-two people were confirmed May 6, 1931.

Twenty-five people were confirmed June 17, 1938.

In June 1925 the church at Four Corners, which had been closed for some years, was reopened and incorporated. The name of the Four Corners Corporation is "Church of St Albert".

The coal camp of Cambria which had been a flourishing mission was closed on March 15, 1928.

"The Church of Corpus Christi" and it's missions are free of  
debt and there is one thousand dollars in the treasury.
