A HISTORY OF THE WYOMING STATE COUNCIL
1903-2001

The first council in the state, Cheyenne Council 801, was instituted July 12, 1903. Four years later, it was placed under the supervision of Territorial Deputy J.H. Conway. Dr. Conway led the Wyoming Knights for nine years. The Wyoming State Council was organized in 1917, but did not hold its first convention until June 5, 1920, in Casper. The first Wyoming State Deputy took office the following year. The forty-eighth and current head of the Wyoming State Council, State Deputy James E. Hasquet, Jr., of Gillette, was first elected to the position in 2001.
