WITNESSES

Witnesses should be able to speak about issues concerning the validity of the marriage in question addressing such topics as the parties' commitment to a life-long union and the procreation and education of children. Other areas of importance include a party's ability to fulfill the essential obligations of being a spouse, especially if a party has brought psychological issues or other serious difficulties to the marital union. These witnesses frequently need to be able to speak about both parties' life history, including the parties' childhood, dating, courtship, decision to marry, and married life. A specific witness may not know the whole story; however, when combined with the testimony of other witnesses, the whole story should become clear. Family and close friends usually make the best witnesses.
